Things To Know Before Your Stay at the original Greenlee Campground

ARRIVAL, DEPARTURE, and DURING YOUR STAY

- All Guests must register at the office before going to your cabin.
- **CHECK-IN time: 2 pm**
- **CHECK-OUT time: 11 am**
- **AFTER 5 pm ARRIVAL:** Notify the office before closing and we will plan for your cabin key.
- **QUIET HOURS:** 11 pm to 7 am
- **OFFICE HOURS:** Monday-Friday 9 am – 5 pm & Saturday 9 am – 2 pm.
Please note Summer Hours (Memorial weekend through Labor Day weekend): the office is open 7 days a week, Monday – Saturday from 9 am until 5 pm & Sunday Noon – 5 pm.
- There is a 2-night minimum on all campsites and cabins and a 3-night minimum on holidays.
- **LATE CHECK-OUT** without notifying office will be assessed an extra night.

- **WORSHIP SERVICES SUNDAYS @ 10 am** from Memorial through Labor Day at the Pavilion near the boat ramp. Please come and join us!

CANCELLATIONS

- Cancellations up to 30 days in advance of arrival date will receive a full refund of deposit. Cancellations from 29 to 8 days before reservation date will receive a credit on account that can then be used in the same calendar year. Cancellations 7 days or less from date of reservation will forfeit their deposit. These policies exclude holidays. Those reservations shall not be refunded, credited nor rescheduled after the 30-day window of arrival.
- No-Shows will be charged for the entire reservation as we will have turned other potential customers away.

NOT ALLOWED AT ANY TIME

- **ABSOLUTELY NO Alcohol or Firearms on the premises!**
- **Anyone damaging or destroying property will be PROMPTLY EVICTED!**

SPEED LIMIT IS 7 MPH FROM THE GATE AND THROUGHOUT THE PARK

GOLF CART POLICIES

- Electric Golf Carts **ONLY!**
- Drivers must be licensed or accompanied by an adult.
- Stay on roads, **NOT** in grass.
- Observe the seating capacity of your cart.
- Headlights are required after dark. Bicycles ridden after dusk must also have headlights.

COMMON COURTESY POLICIES

- Please use courtesy and common sense in keeping your cabin tidy.
- Clean up all trash before leaving and deposit in dumpster.
- Bagged trash **ONLY** in dumpsters.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for the safety and actions of your children.

PET POLICIES

- **ALL** pets must always be kept on a leash and under the owners' control.
- Clean up after your pet.
- Keep noise to a minimum.
- **CABINS:** Pets only 40 lbs or less and must be crated if left unattended.

DOCK and RAMP POLICIES

- **NO** fishing, swimming, or throwing nets from the dock or launch ramps.
- **NO** parking/blocking dock walkway, launch ramps, or campsites.
- **NO** swimming within 100 yards of boat dock due to **ELECTRIC SHOCK HAZARD RISK.**
- Due to our **TN CLEAN MARINA** designation, **NO** gasoline/petroleum products are to be poured into a boat, jet ski, etc. anywhere on Greenlee property.

POOL RULES (Coming 2025)

- **WARNING: NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY!**
- Users must **SIGN IN** at the **OFFICE!**
- **CHILDREN UNDER 12 YEARS OLD MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT!**
- **SHOWER BEFORE ENTERING POOL!**
- **NO FOOD/DRINK OR ANIMALS** inside the fence!
- **NO DIVING** or **RUNNING!**

CANCELLATIONS

- Any cancellation must be received 14 days before reservation arrival to receive full credit of deposit that can then be redeemed within the same calendar year. **NO REFUNDS** will be given.
- Holiday cancellations/no shows will be charged the entire 3 days as we will have turned other potential customers away.
